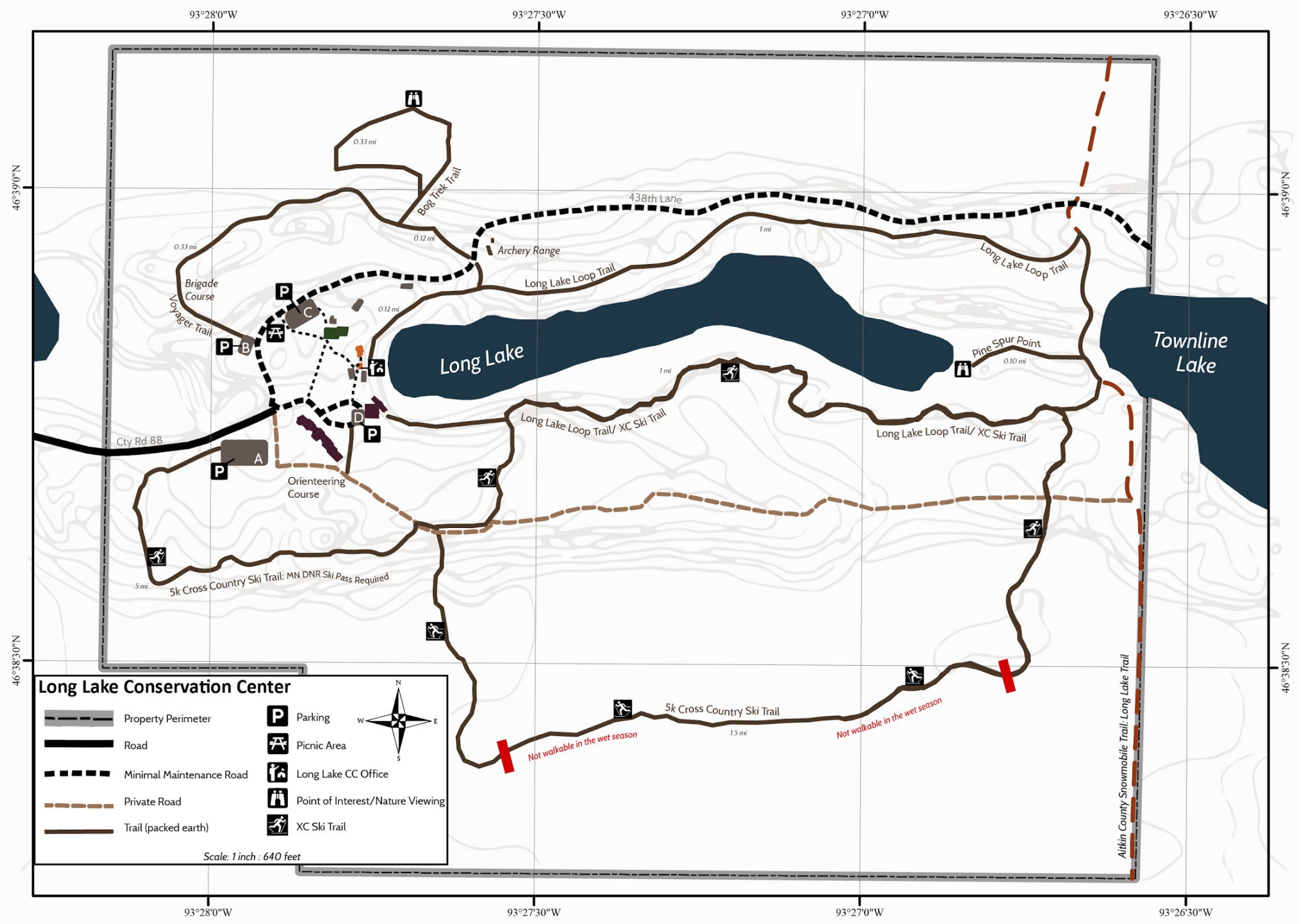


Long Lake Conservation Center Trail Map

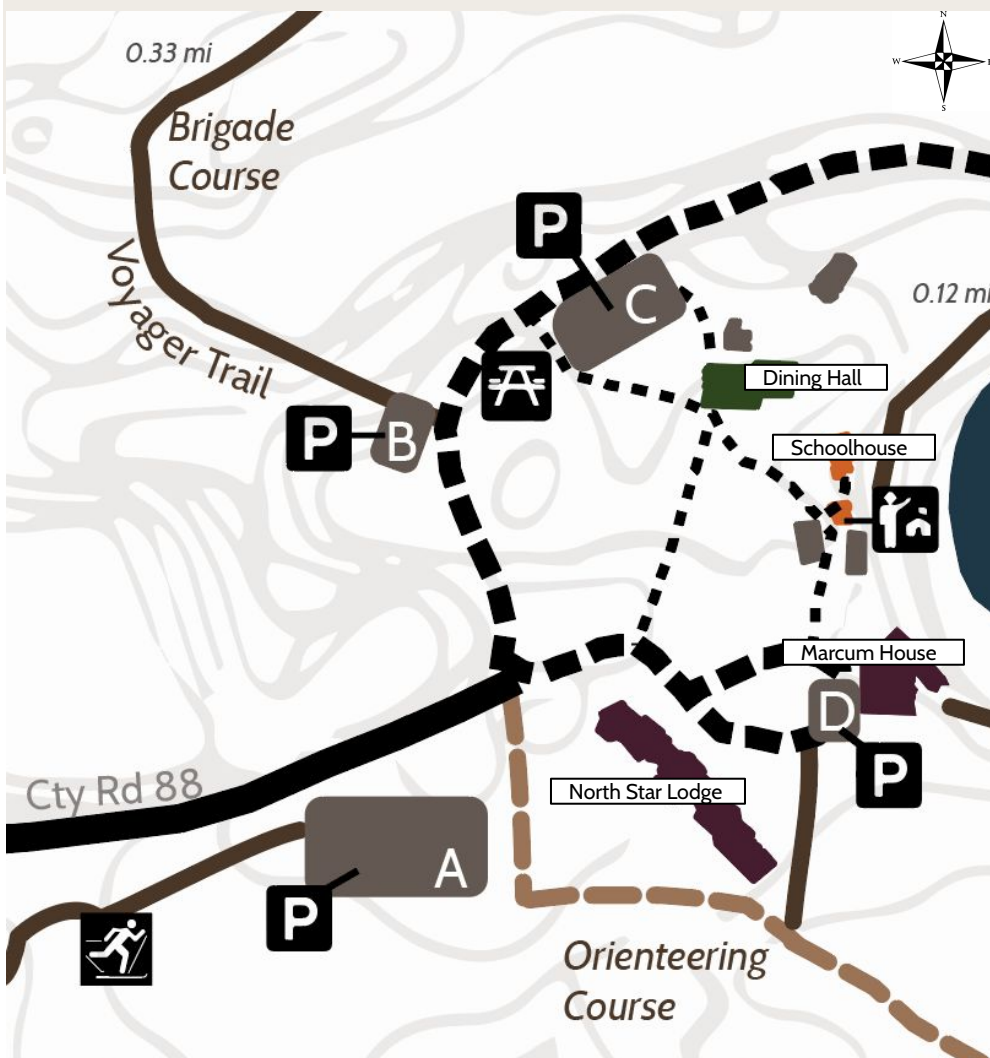


CAMPUS MAP

Park Hours:

Park is open from dawn to dusk.



Vehicle Permits:

Permits are not required for parking.
