RETREAT PACKAGES – per person, 3-4 persons per room

1 night = one night lodging, and up to 4 meals	\$160	\$185	\$205
2 nights = two nights lodging, and up to 5 meals	\$210	\$220	\$245

4 nights = four nights lodging, and up to 7 meals	\$300	\$320	\$345

*Minimum of 15 paying participants is required.

WINTER DISCOUNT - December, January and February

Bring your group to Long Lake during the winter months and get an additional night FREE (stay for 4 nights, pay for 3)

Meal plan includes dinner on the night of arrival, brunch and dinner on each full day, and brunch on your departure day.

Full facility use only (no lodging or meals) = \$350 per day

Lodging only (no meals) = \$65 per person, per night

Meeting space (no meals or lodging) = \$150

Optional Guided Naturalist Activities - \$100 for groups of 24 or less, \$150 for groups of 25 or more: Your group may opt to participate in an optional Guided Naturalist Activity. Choices include: bog walk, canoe excursion, lake hike, snowshoeing, or cross country skiing.

ADDITIONAL LODGING OPTIONS:

- Double Occupancy – add \$65 per person
- Single Occupancy – add \$85 per person

A la carte food charge:

Breakfast - \$13 per person

Brunch - \$15 per person

Lunch - \$14 per person

Standard Dinner - \$18 per person

Specialty Dinner - starting at \$20 (farm-to-fork, or special menu options)

Room Charge:

Use of rooms other than lodging is subject to a \$50 per day rental fee.

Holiday Surcharge:

An additional \$350 surcharge is applied to any bookings that fall on a holiday.

Check-in: 3 p.m. on date of arrival (subject to change, dependent on Long Lake calendar)

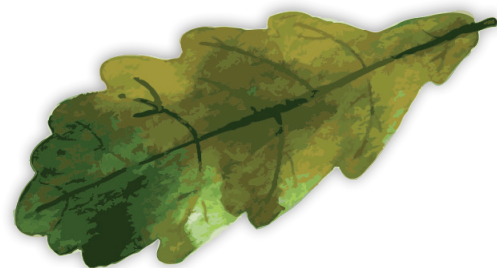
Check-out: 3 p.m. on date of departure (subject to change, dependent on Long Lake calendar)

Cancellations:

Any cancellations within 7 days of your retreat will be charged at 50%, as staff has already been scheduled and food has already been ordered.

Emergencies / Liability waivers:

All Long Lake staff are certified in First Aid and CPR. In the event of an emergency, the group coordinator is responsible for calling 911 and notifying a Long Lake Manager. Liability waivers must be signed and returned by all participants.



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
