## Legislative-Citizen Commission on Minnesota Resources

Funding for this scholarship was provided by the Minnesota Environment and Natural Resources Trust Fund as recommended by the Legislative-Citizen Commission on Minnesota Resources (LCCMR). The Trust Fund is a permanent fund constitutionally established by the citizens of Minnesota to assist in the protection, conservation, preservation, and enhancement of the state's air, water, land, fish, wildlife, and other natural resources. Currently 40% of net Minnesota State Lottery proceeds are dedicated to growing the Trust Fund and ensuring future benefits for Minnesota's environment and natural resources.

The purpose of this scholarship is to allow a minimum of 20,000 students in underserved communities to attend one of Minnesota's six Residential Environmental Learning Centers. The size of the scholarship your school can receive is dependent on your school demographics; specifically the number of students who receive Free and Reduced Price Lunch. Long Lake is able to offer full scholarships to students who receive Free or Reduced Lunch, but the total amount of scholarships offered must not exceed 90% of the total school field trip fees.
